

The Western Monmouth Utilities Authority, Monmouth County's premier environmental government agency, is excited to be expanding the staff of dedicated and valued professionals who maintain our critical wastewater infrastructure by seeking a Manager of Asset Protection to join our management team. Under the supervision of the Director of the Engineering Services Department, this position is primarily responsible for the maintenance of and upgrades to our newly-implemented web-based VUEWorks software package that will handle our asset management, GIS and work order systems. While this is mainly a data management role, the incumbent can expect to spend up to 50% of their time performing data collection and management responsibilities in the field which may include locating, opening, surveying, investigating and closing wastewater manholes and other sewer infrastructure located in a wide variety of settings from urban streets to rural backwoods and farms. As a member of the Engineering Services Department, the incumbent may be assigned other duties and responsibilities as needed including performing operational triage on a wide variety of technologies and systems as well as coordinating with other managers, staff and contractors.

The successful candidate must be proficient in MS Office (specifically including Excel) and have experience in database and/or spreadsheet development and management. They will also have general knowledge of computer networks and security, have experience using asset management and work order maintenance software. Familiarity using ESRI ArcGIS and cloud-based GIS systems is key to the success of the candidate. Finally, the successful candidate will hold an Associates Degree (or equivalent credit hours towards a Bachelor Degree), be able to lift fifty pounds safely and hold and maintain a valid Driver's License. While not required, candidates with experience using Computer-Aided Design and GNSS survey equipment are highly desirable. This is a full-time, salaried, management position.
